Sharpe, *A Handlist of the Latin Writers of Great Britain & Ireland before 1540*, (1997), p.770. considers the attribution “opus fratris Gwillielmi de la Furmenterie Anglici quondam de ordine fraturm minorum” in the colophon of BL Royal 8.C.XVI to be spurious: “its circulation argues strongly against its being the work of an obscure English friar”. Nothing further in the supplement to Sharpe's *Handlist*, either on William of Furmenterie or William of Gloucester.
